## **AVOID the 20—DUI Checkpoint**

Fifteen Salinas Police Officers and 3 Community Service Officers conducted a DUI / Driver's License Checkpoint near the intersection of Williams Road and Barden Road in Salinas between the hours of 6pm and 10:30pm.

983 vehicles went through the checkpoint

596 drivers were contacted by police officers

1 driver was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol (25-year-old female driver submitted to a breath test with results of .23 BAC; nearly three times the legal limit)

5 other drivers were cited for driving on a suspended license

17 traffic citations were written down to drivers making illegal turns who were trying to avoid the checkpoint
