Suspected Drunk Driver Arrested After Crash With Salinas Police Car!

SALINAS, Calif. - A 20-year-old man has been arrested after Salinas Police say he crashed with a patrol car while under the influence.

The collision was reported at approximately 12:45 a.m. Saturday at Natividad Road and East Laurel Drive.

According to the police department, an officer was making a left turn from westbound Laurel onto southbound Natividad when he was sideswiped by a Toyota Camry.

Police say the officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle, and the driver -- identified as Jose Luis Jimenez -- showed signs of intoxication. They say the DUI investigation revealed Jimenez's level of intoxication to be more than twice the legal limit.

Jimenez was arrested and later booked into the Monterey County Jail on charges of driving under the influence and driving without a license.
