


PUEBLO DEL MAR MARINA

The STEPS students showed leadership and initiative by presenting information and statistics about recovery to their teachers and peers, and wore purple ribbons to show their support. They shared the message of a "**Bright Future**" for **EVERYONE**, as long as you commit yourself to making positive and healthy decisions.


