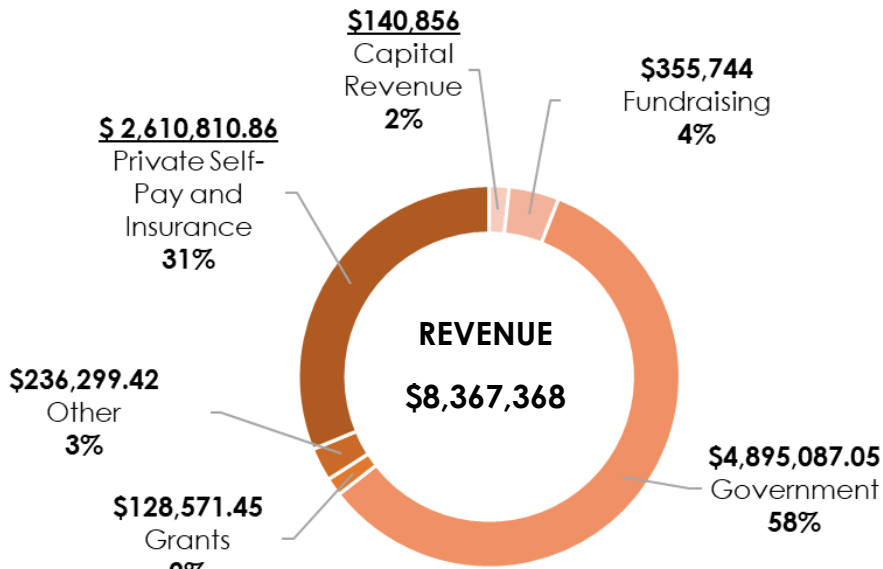
Grantors, Making a Difference in the Community during the pandemic!

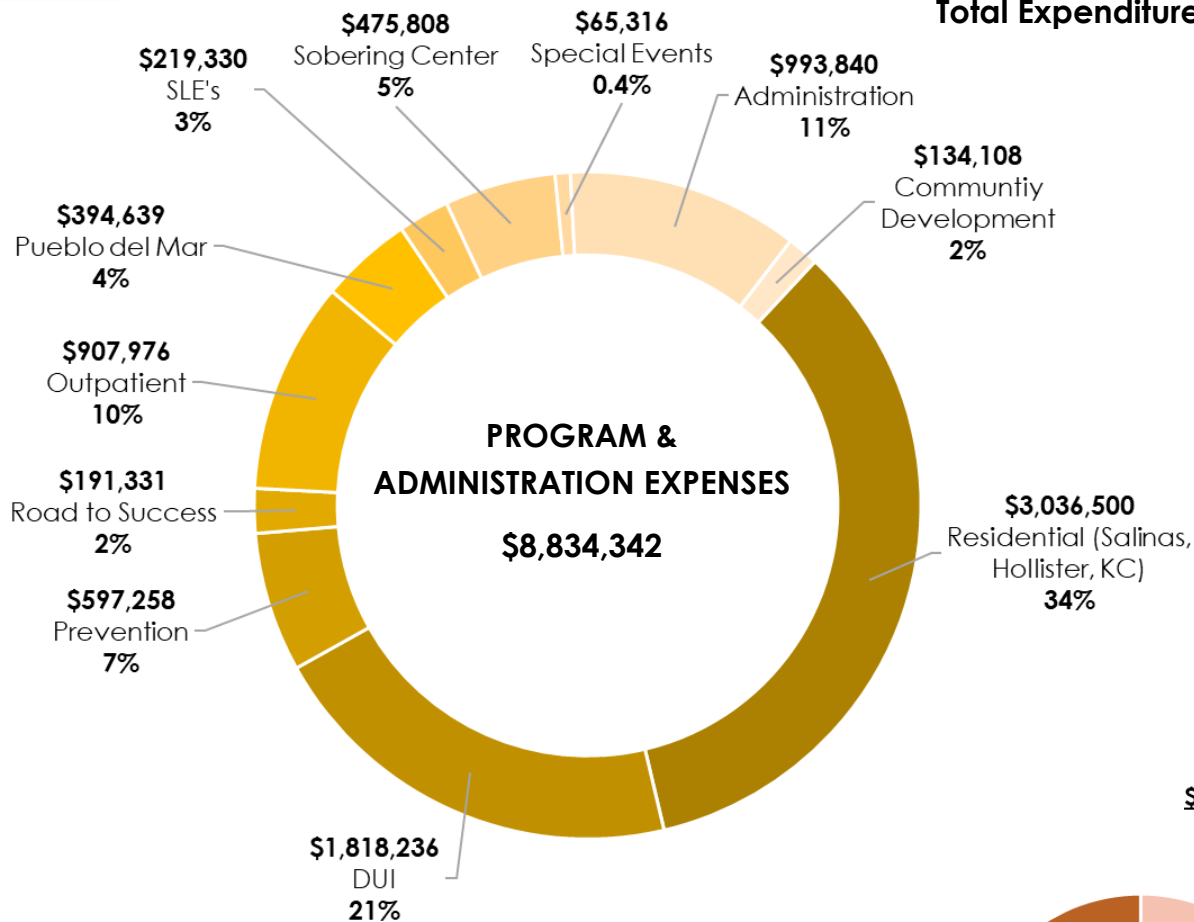

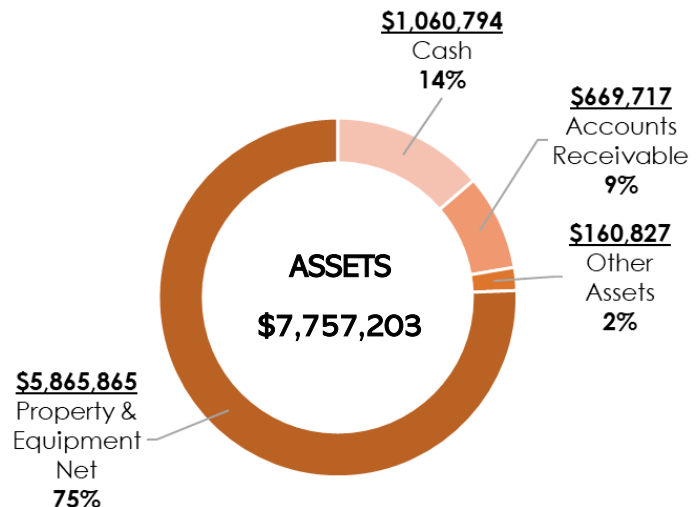

SOBERING CENTER & DUI

The **Sobering Center**, located in the center of Salinas is designed to help individuals charged with public intoxication or driving under the influence (DUI) charges to avoid jail time, so that they can receive the right care, to eventually begin recovery the right away. This program was **up 45%** from last year and provided care to **369 individuals** who would have otherwise have see jail time. This program reduces officers hours off the streets and down to a ten minute drop off policy so they can return to protecting and serving the community.

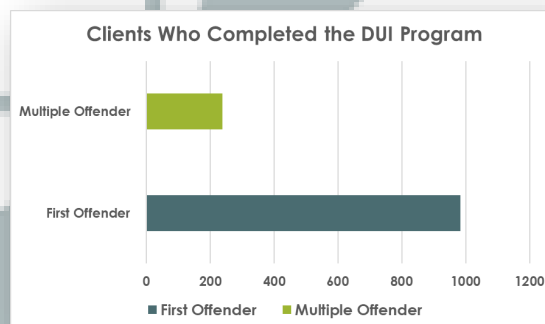

The **DUI Program** at Sun Street Centers is centered on providing education and group process to help the client understand their relationship with alcohol, drugs, and the inevitable risk of driving while under the influence. **1,744 DUI CLIENTS** received quality prevention classes in Monterey County this last fiscal year.
