San Luis Obispo Residential

In July 2023, one year after its opening, the San Luis Obispo (SLO) Men's Residential Program presented its successes to the **San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors**. Now, we mark our two-year anniversary of providing services in San Luis Obispo.

Over the past year, 2023-2024, Sun Street Centers has served **137 residents of San Luis Obispo County** through our **treatment and recovery programs** located in San Luis Obispo, King City, Hollister, and Salinas. Feedback from our clients has been positive, with **79%** of clients seeing improvements in their **relationships** and **90%** of clients reporting improvements in their **mental health**. We thank our community partners, dedicated staff, and board members for their unwavering support in making these successes possible.

Thanks to **Sandy Quintana**, Sun Street Centers' **Women's Residential** clients have a new, **lovely**, shaded meeting space, dubbed Jaclyn's Gazebo in honor of **Jaclyn Quintana**. Sandy is a mother who exemplifies grace during the hardest of times and a community member who reaches out to women traumatized by their **substance use**. She lost her daughter, Jaclyn, aged 28, November 28, 2023. Jaclyn lives on as an organ and tissue donor. Sandy carried on Jaclyn's generosity by raising nearly **\$6,000** for Sun Street Centers' Women's Residential Treatment Program that supports **single women** and **women with children** who are seeking recovery from substance use disorder. Sandy was named Sun Street Centers' **2024 Outstanding Philanthropist** by the **Community Foundation for San Benito County**.



Building For Recovery

In FY2023-2024, we raised **\$1,388,284** for our **Building for Recovery Campaign**. **\$1,116,784** came directly from Sun Street Centers **donors!** This pushed us ever closer to our \$5.4 million goal and insured we will be providing services at this site for many years to come. The amazing outpouring of **support** shows just how **valued** Sun Street Centers' programs are valued in our **community**. Construction began on the Recovery Center in April of 2024 and we are on pace to open for services in Fall of 2025.

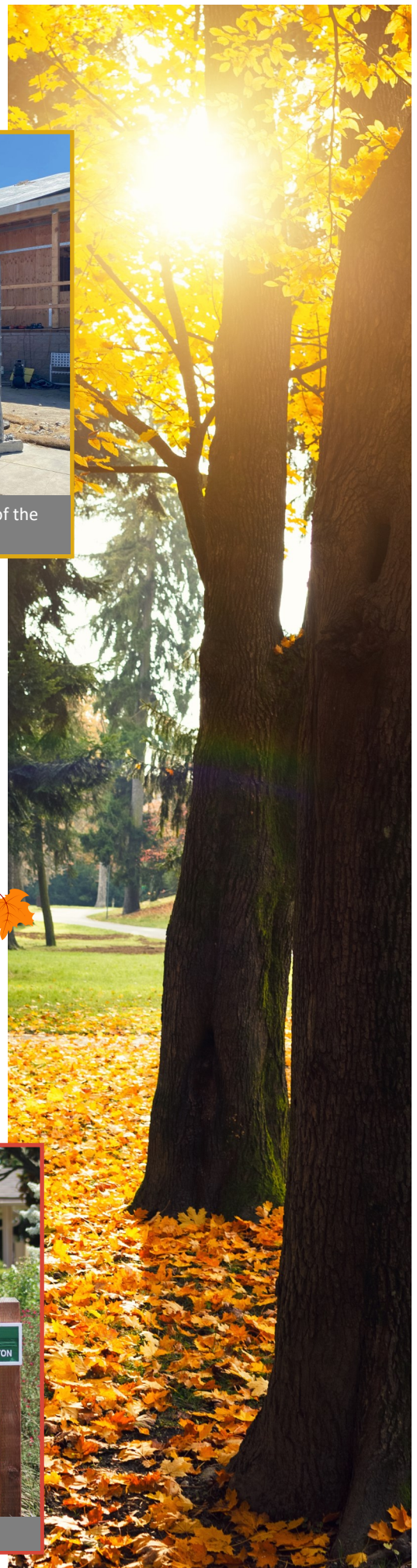


Anne C. Leach Scholarship Fund

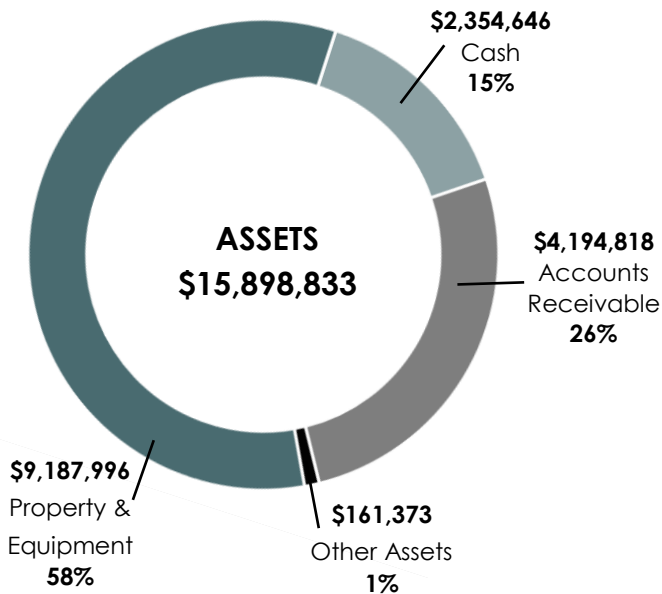

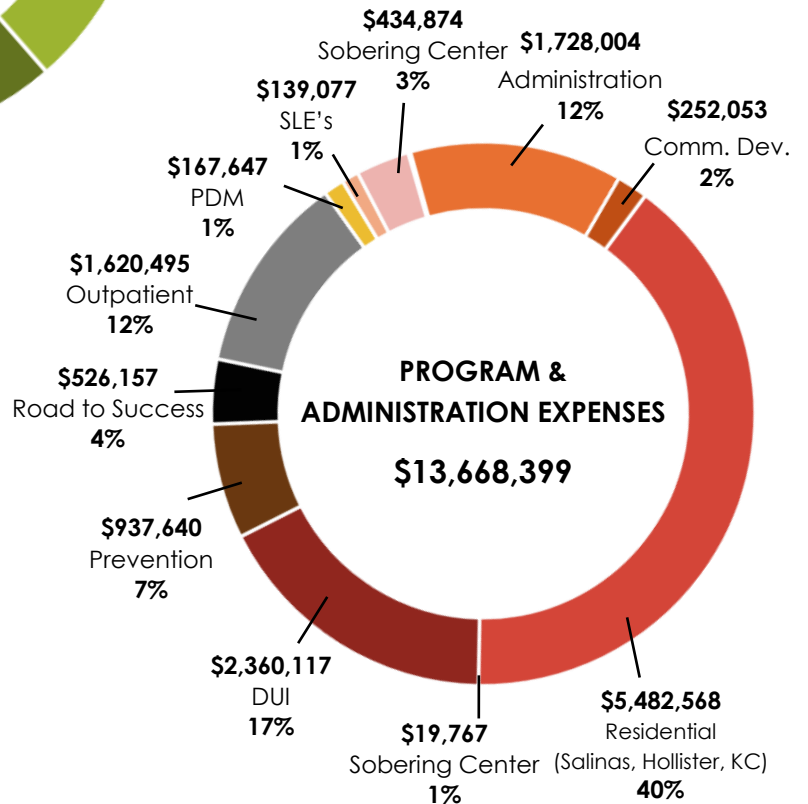
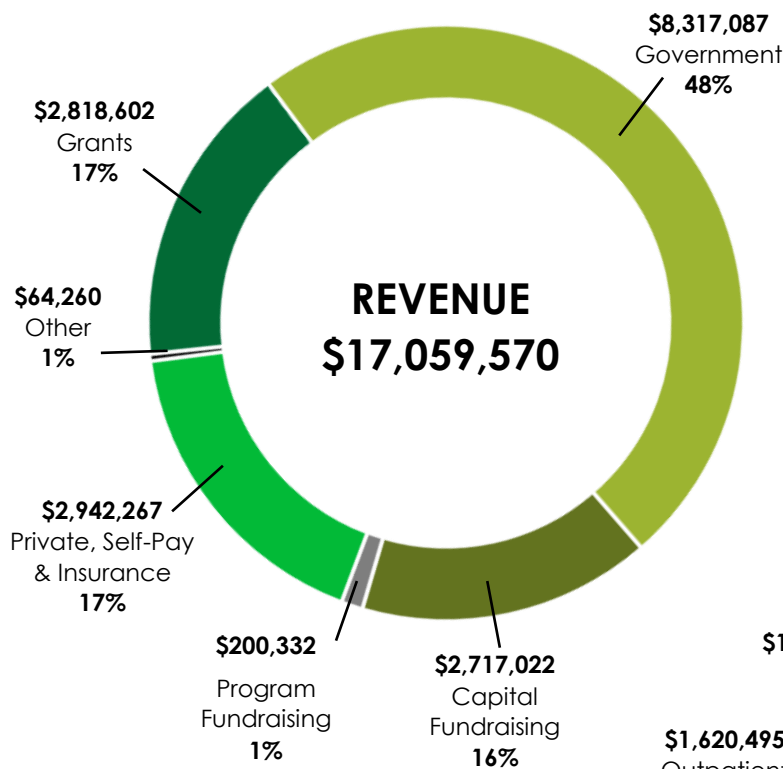
